History of MFEAT & ABA in Manitoba


- Manitoba Families for Effective Autism Treatment (MFEAT; <u>www.mfeat.ca</u>)

 Fully funded service
- In partnership with MFEAT, the provincial government, and St. Amant, the School Age ABA Interim Funded program opened with 13 children in 2005
 56 children this year

MFEAT & ABA in Manitoba

- As of September 2008 the permanent Government funded 3-year School Age ABA Program
- MFEAT is continuing to work with St. Amant and Government to planfor what happens after the 3 years;
 - Defining what was referred to as 'other types of ABA services'.
 - Working towards a "need vs. # of years" basis.
 - Creating a transitioning criteria for children who are ready.
- Information will be shared with families as developments occur.
- Families are encouraged to attend monthly MFEAT meetings.
- Visioning event is in progress to create new structure that will assist MFEAT in achieving current goals and serve our members better.
